The Putnam County Board of Education is conducting a special bond election on Saturday, August 29, 2009 that includes \$20,581,240 for the construction of a new Buffalo High School.

If the bond passes, the new Buffalo High School will include:

- Approximately 88,000 square feet
- New classrooms
- New computer labs
- New science labs
- New library/media center
- New dining room
- New kitchen
- New gymnasium with lockers
- New auxiliary gymnasium
- New auditorium
- Performance stage with dressing rooms
- Drama classrooms
- Music/band suite
- Art classroom
- Office suite with conference areas
- Faculty planning areas
- New restrooms
- Storage areas

The new Buffalo High School will be built to house approximately 400 students in grades 9-12 and will be located on the property owned by the Board of Education in the town of Buffalo.
